C.W. HOOD YACHTS launches the first truly New England inspired, fully electric center console. The beautiful Hood 26E was conceived, designed and built right here in Marblehead. Chris Hood and designer David Robison set out to create a new vessel from the keel up, specifically for emerging EV technology, yet styled more like a classic yacht than a spaceship.

Her environmentally friendly electric propulsion is super quiet, easily operated and monitored from a touch screen at the helm or even your smart phone. Two electric motors power a single duo-prop stern drive, delivering jaw-dropping acceleration, full control around the dock, and the ability to be trimmed up out of the way at the beach.

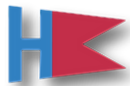
Lithium-Ion batteries are easily charged overnight using standard marina shore power, or in just a few hours with a rapid charging unit. Public charging stations will eventually be a common sight in every harbor. (OVER)

The carbon fiber hull and deck are rock solid yet light as a feather, and its current gray primer hull and deck will soon be finished in Awlgrip, with a handy swim platform, powder-coated rails, custom cushions and of course, a large Yeti cooler for summer excursions.

The classic teak console is the boat's only varnished bright work, in keeping with the perfect balance of low maintenance, durability and beauty.

In sea trials around Marblehead Harbor in November, with runs to Manchester and Gloucester, she performed even better than expected, and with plenty of range for a great day out on the water.

She is FUN! FAST! and QUIET! With a top speed of 42 knots.
